Dear parent / carer,

As you will have heard, the government has asked us to prepare for some sort of face to face support for students in Year 10. This could begin from 1 June 2020.

We have discussed how we might achieve this and are in the process of formulating a plan. We are hoping to be able to offer each student in Year 10 the opportunity to attend school one day a week for 3 hours. They would be in a small group of no more than 10 students. Your child would be allocated a day to attend. On the other days they would continue to work on their Google Classroom work at home.

On each day teachers will be assigned to a group to support – these teachers will be from a range of subjects which will always include English, maths and science. Laptops will be available for each child to use. We would endeavour to assign the same teachers each week in line with government guidance. Social distancing rules would be respected at all times and we would follow all of the published government guidance regarding thorough cleaning, hand washing facilities and other risk reducing strategies.
